CUSTODY AND CARE OF NJROTC UNIFORM

- 1. All Cadets in the NJROTC Program at John D.Obryant are issued a Navy JROTC Uniform. The uniform is an important element in the morale, pride, discipline, and effectiveness of the NJROTC Program in our School. It is important for NJROTC Cadets to maintain a high standard of dress and personal appearance. The key elements are neatness, cleanliness, and military image. The uniform projects an image of devotion to the NJROTC Program.
- 2. The Navy directs the NJROTC uniform worn by all the cadets at least one full school day each week (normally on Thursday) and on other occasions as prescribed by Senior Naval Instructor (like drills, ceremonies, and parades).
- 3. The care of the uniform is the responsibility of the cadet and the parent. The unit does not have laundry and dry cleaning service. Uniforms shall be kept clean, neat, and in good repair. You receive the clean and they need be returned in same condition.
- 4. Once the uniform is issued to your cadet, he/she will provide you with a NJROTC generated Custody Card. Both Cadet and parent sign the Custody Card and return it to the units Administration Officer along with the remaining paperwork required by the unit.
- 5. The original NJROTC JUMS generated Custody Card showing the issued items along with both signatures will remain with the unit Admin Officer because it is an accountable item for our annual inspection with the United States Navy.
